Money owed should be ready for collection from 29 December. Please ask at the Box office for a sales list and any money owed.

Manning the Exhibition

We would ask that each stall holder would be in residence in the gallery for a minimum of one whole day or 2 half days to form a rota of cover for the duration of the exhibition, to insure the security of yours and others work and to be in charge of sales. If appropriate, you would be more than welcome to bring work to do during this time.
